



Operating System Requirements and Compatibility

Windows 98, Windows ME, Windows 2000

- Microsoft no longer supports Windows 98, we suggest upgrading. (<http://www.shopcowsense.com/default.aspx?cat=computers>).
- You cannot use Pocket Cow Sense on Windows 98 due to Microsoft ActiveSync incompatibility.
- Cow Sense core programs will install and operate without issue.

Windows XP

- Full compatibility for 32-bit version of Windows XP.
- If you are running the 64-bit version of Windows XP, you must use Virtual PC with a 32-bit operating system in order to run Cow Sense (and any other 16-bit applications). Refer to <http://www.microsoft.com/windows/virtual-pc/support/virtual-pc-2007.aspx>.

Windows Vista

- Full compatibility for 32-bit version of Windows Vista with User Account Control (UAC) turned off.
- User Account Control (UAC) must be turned off to properly install and operate Cow Sense on 32-bit Vista. Refer to <http://www.cowsense.com/docs/psb/psb011.pdf>.
- If you are running the 64-bit version of Windows Vista, you must use Virtual PC with a 32-bit operating system in order to run Cow Sense (and any other 16-bit applications). Refer to <http://www.microsoft.com/windows/virtual-pc/support/virtual-pc-2007.aspx>.

Windows 7

- Full compatibility for 32-bit version of Windows 7 with User Account Control (UAC) at the lowest setting.
- User Account Control (UAC) must be at the lowest setting to properly install and operate Cow Sense on 32-bit Windows 7. Refer to <http://www.cowsense.com/docs/psb/psb011.pdf>.
- If you are running the 64-bit version of Windows 7, you must install and use XP Mode in order to run 16-bit applications like Cow Sense. Refer to <http://www.microsoft.com/windows/virtual-pc/default.aspx>.

Macintosh / Apple
